

BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SAFETY NET

For individuals who are 3 years of age or older, have a qualifying mental health diagnosis, and have no behavioral health insurance, you may qualify for the Behavioral Health Safety Net (BHSN) of TN program. Services provided by this program include assessment, evaluation, diagnostic, therapeutic intervention, case management, transportation, peer support services, psychosocial rehabilitation services, psychiatric medication management, labs related to medication management and pharmacy assistance, and coordination.



Obtain up-to-date information on alcohol, drug, problem gambling, and other addictions.



Referral resource for Tennesseans seeking help for these conditions as well as co-occurring mental health challenges.
