Resources for immigrants can often be limited, making it challenging for many to access the support they need.
However, there are certain programs and organizations that aim to bridge this gap, offering assistance to those who qualify.

Here are programs that currently benefit immigrant families and children:

Cover Kids

Low-income pregnant mothers are eligible for CoverKids no matter their immigration status. This provides pregnancy-related care and postpartum care for 2 months.

TennCare & TANF

All infants and children born in the US are eligible for all public benefits, and enrollment does not affect their parents immigration status as of January 2025.

Tennessee WIC
