THE FAMILY TOGETHER

This section focuses on the family system. The first step is to define who makes up the family. Generally it is a household but sometimes two households in which the children spend considerable amounts of time could be considered (e.g. divorced parents with 50:50 visitation).



Item	Score	Justification/Narrative
Financial Resources	1	5/3/23: The mother is not employed but she does receive disability. 5/11/23- No change 10/11/23: Mom is currently employed with a currier service and also receives SSI.
Residential Stability	3	5/3/23: The mother was evicted from her home and has moved in with a family friend. 5/11/23- No change 10/11/23: The mother and ACV have moved in with a family friend but she is paying rent in the home. 11/9/23: AP was in a domestic altercation with her previous friend that she was living with; she and ACV were kicked out of the home and an OP was placed on her. Joelene is now homeless but ACV is staying with AP's boss. ACV was temporarily placed with S on 11/9.




TCOM-System View

(2021 - 2024)









Child Traumatic Needs by Tennessee Region (2021 - 2024)

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
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


